West Lake Tahoe Regional Water Treatment Plant**

Project Details:

The Tahoe City Public Utility District (TCPUD) is beginning construction of a new drinking water treatment plant to replace the existing seasonal plant located at Chambers Landing. The new water treatment plant will be located at 275 Lodge Drive and will provide a permanent, drought-resistant, drinking water source to the west shore of Lake Tahoe for water supply and fire protection purposes.

Work Timeframe:


Construction is expected to begin in mid-July 2021. This is a multi-year project and construction will continue through 2024. Construction efforts in 2021 will primarily affect the water treatment plant property at 275 Lodge Drive and the public right-of-way(s) of Lodge Drive and Flicker Ave, between Chamberland Drive and Lodge Drive. Work activities are limited to the TRPA-approved working hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., excluding Sundays and holidays. During this time, there will be heavy equipment operation and construction noise from tree removal, earthwork, and excavation activities. Traffic control will be provided for work impacting the public right-of-way.
